According to the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic relations art. 7 provisions, "in the case of military, naval or air attaches, the receiving State may require their names to be submitted beforehand, for its approval". The Diplomatic Mission is requested to send a Verbal Note to the MFAEI, Curriculum Vitae of the military, naval or air Attaché for the approval granted by the competent authorities of the Republic of Moldova.
