TURN OVER

Regulations for flight and landing permits in the " Decree concerning in Surveillance of Finland's Territory and the Protection of Its Territorial Integrity (1069/1989, 219/1994 and 128/1996)"

A flight and landing permit is required for

- military aircraft –
- frontier guard aircraft
- police aircraft
- customs aircraft
- aircraft performing courier, charting and other similar services for state purpose
- aircraft, the crew of which consist of military persons

An application for a flight and landing permit shall be submitted

- in good time, at least six working days* before the estimated arrival of the aircraft in Finnish territory
- through diplomatic channels using the appropriate Defence Staff form

* A request submitted later than this will be accepted only when warranted by very important reasons

Furthermore, an aircraft entering Finnish territory shall observe applicable aviation rules and regulations in force in Finland
